The current, post-Fall 1999, English major has level, distribution, and concentration requirements. To meet the level requirements, the student must complete at least 36 hours of courses numbered above 199. Of these required courses, no more than 15 hours may be at the 200 level, the remaining 21 must be above 299, including at least 6 above 399. To meet the distribution requirement, a student must complete 24 hours of coursework from prescribed areas described below, and 12 hours in an area of Concentration, also described below. Each course must consist of 3 hours.
